Who to book, in what order, and what each typically costs, so due diligence runs on a schedule instead of a scramble.

The Usual Order

Professional	Why	Typical Cost Range	Booked For
Conveyancer	Contract review and the conveyance itself, before you commit to anything (a settlement agent in WA; in Queensland and the ACT this is solicitors' work)	\$800 to \$1,500 for the matter	
Solicitor	Review of the contract, disclosures and any complex conditions, disputes or unusual title matters	Often fixed-fee for a review; hourly beyond	
Building inspector	Structure, defects, safety	\$400 to \$800	
Pest inspector	Termites and timber pests, often bundled with building	\$250 to \$450	
Surveyor	Boundaries where fences and plans disagree	\$600 to \$1,200	
Valuer	A formal figure where you want independence	\$300 to \$600	
Broker or lender	Finance approval in writing	Usually free to you
